If you scroll down the HP map attachment there is the ord survey map of the area. But also have a look at Google Maps.

1. If coming in from Bohal, Molac then the D775... (get off at the water tower, you'll see the SuperU on the left), turn right and follow signs to Caden 5 mins) ...then watch the one way system - you will come in and leave the church on your left, hug it all the way round so you literally do a U around it. Then you will be facing the Pharmacie. Turn right)

2. We tend to use this route as the dual carriageways are really coming on = If coming in via Redon, be careful that the satnav doesn't take you around all the country roads - just go through Redon and head towards, but not into Allaire on D775 and turn off left direction La Croisette, Caden. Here, it's country roads and obviously, this way you don't go into Caden and so you will need to watch the map carefully. If you get into Bourg Maria, you've just gone too far.

We go through the light blue double gates to the property, unpack and then park the car outside again on the grass by the little house. There's Marcel and his wife opposite and Jean and his wife in the farm house and they are all lovely helpful people.

More details for Route 1 - Once out of Caden....

..... you will have the memorial (*calv* on the map) on the left, then you will go past the tennis courts on your left, then the recycling area and then you are heading off into the countryside with houses dotted along the road.

5 minutes along the road you will come to a wiggly bit and you can see on the map 'Chap' - it's the disused chapel in the tiny winy hamlet of Bourg Maria, which is a very very pretty set of houses and sheds. Get ready to turn right, there's an old sign pointing to Le Haut Provost. Turn down there and it's on your left.

We've arrived, where shall we go for a bit of a recce?

Note on the map just before the chapel it says '79'. If you walk down there to the bottom, then left, (or the other way around) it's a pleasant evening stroll.

Also, if you notice at the top right it says Chat(eau). Walk into Bourg Maria, then right, you can do a decent block which comes out at the chateau (privately owned, pretty impressive) and then down and out onto the main road for 100 yards.

Do go down past Jean's house (other neighbour) and then left down the track and into the woods as it is very beautiful, especially at the bottom where there is a little bridge.
