- **Honfleur** for breakfast (buy in a boulangerie and sit on the keyside) is an absolute must – famous for painting. Beautiful old harbour, little alleys and old half-timbered buildings + must go into the church.
- **Villedieu les Poëles** for lunch - nice café half way down the main part of the main street on the left) – it's famous for its copper products and large bell making.
- **Fougères** for afternoon stop and visit to chateau which is very imposing
- At Rennes we take the signs south to **Redon** then west to **Allaire** then **Caden**. Note that coming in this way you do not go through Caden itself.
